





# BEHAVIORAL HEALTH CRISIS CENTERS (BHCC)



#### WHAT DOES A BHCC DO?

- Provide a trauma-informed space to receive services from a multi-disciplinary team specializing in mental health and substance use-related crises.
- Triage, assess, stabilize, and provide immediate resources to individuals in crisis.
- Provide linkages to community resources (including outpatient treatment) to ensure continued safety and stability for the individual.
- Provide an alternative to the emergency room or jail for those with behavioral health symptoms.

## **(6)** BHCC FY25 IMPACTS

- BHCCs in Missouri served 50, 411 referrals.
- The Client was stabilized 88% of the time, with the remaining percentage either transferring or leaving against advice.
- On referrals from law enforcement, the average law enforcement time spent on a referral - seven minutes.
