

Behavioral Health & IDD (BHIDD) Learning Collaborative

Discussion Notes

- We learned what each provider type does for a living.
- We shared the need for DBH and DD providers to **partner with each other** and capitalize on each provider's specific strengths rather than trying to do everything themselves.
- Several regions raised the **need for a BHIDD coordinator/liaison** at the provider level due to the difficulties and complications of navigating multiple systems and services.
- It was asked that **peer support specialist service** be added back to the DD waiver.
- It was asked that the state plan be amended to **allow case management regardless of diagnosis**.
- It was asked that **DD providers be added to formal provider partnership incentives**.
- We need to align rates for telehealth and share the cost savings achieved by using things like Station MD/mobile units/etc.

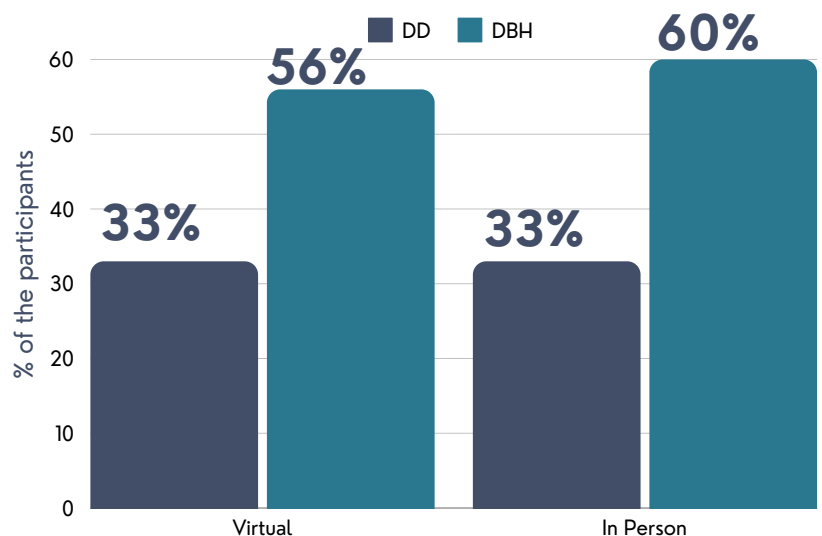
