Rapid Access Unit

The Rapid Access Unit is for immediate psychiatric care and crisis intervention. Services include: peer support, medication consultation and prescribing, medication assisted treatment for opioid use, crisis therapy, referrals and connection to care.

Admission Criteria

- 18+ years old
- Medically stable
- BAC 0.29 or below
- Ability to safely receive care in a voluntary treatment environment
- Ability to perform ADL's independently
- Must be own guardian, or have appointed guardian available at admission

Referral Process

- Individuals may self-refer (walk-in)
- Hospitals and Emergency Departments can call or simply refer for walk-in at any time
- Community partners may also call with referral information
- Law enforcement may bring individuals to the RAU at any time
